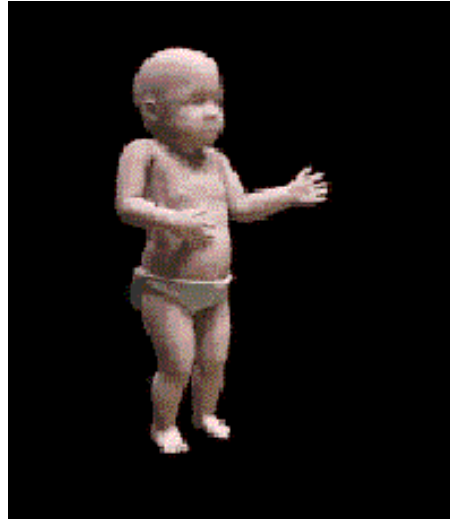
What does grown up mean?
